Conditions of Entry

- 1. Talkin Tarn Regatta is open to British Rowing affiliated clubs and international clubs affiliated to a national governing body recognised by World Rowing.
- 2. Talkin Tarn Regatta will be held under the British Rowing Rules of Racing.
- 3. Talkin Tarn Regatta will take place at Talkin Tarn Country Park, Brampton, CA8 1HN.
- 4. Any competitor, boat, blade or cox may enter only <u>ONE</u> event per division. Doubling up within a division is strictly prohibited.
- 5. Fees are £10 per seat for adults and £8 per seat for junior events. No fee for coxes.
- 6. Entries close at 12pm (noon) on Wednesday 21st June 2023. Entries may be suspended sooner if capacity is reached. All entry fees must be paid via BROE by that time. No refunds of entry fees will be given after the draw has been made.
- 7. The draw will take place on Sunday 25th June 2023 and will be published on www.talkintarnarc.co.uk prior to the event.
- 8. The Organising Committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries in an event, cancel an event or shorten the regatta course for safety or practical reasons, giving as much notice as possible.
- 9. A minimum of three entries from two different clubs are required for an event to be held

 two at the Organising Committee's discretion. If insufficient entries are received, the entries will be
 placed in the next age group or status group for the class of boat unless an alternative is clearly
 stated. Please state clearly if NOT prepared to move up.
- 10. After entries close, the ranking points of crews will be reviewed to ensure fair competition. Where necessary, banding will be used. The Organising Committee reserve the right to merge events if numbers are insufficient to hold separately. Please state clearly if not prepared to race in this situation. Senior and junior events may be banded by ranking points, depending on entries, at the Regatta Committee's discretion.
- 11. Masters events may be raced by age category using the handicap system. Masters Handicaps are at the Organising Committee's discretion will be applied at the start in accordance with guidance laid down in the British Rowing Rules of Racing.
- 12. Division start times on this notice are provisional and may be adjusted. Crews must be able to race at any time during the division entered.
- 13. If there are any major changes to race timings, this information will be shared as soon as possible. It is the competitor's duty to check for updates.
- 14. Talkin Tarn Regatta is a three-lane course; please ensure that all crews are able to back onto a stern-boat start.
- 15. Competitors must provide their own boats and blades.
- 16. All boats must be fitted with an empacher slot on the bow in which to fit the boat numbers.
- 17. Coxes requiring dead weight must bring their own, clearly identifiable, weights.
- 18. Competitors who decide to scratch before the Regatta should inform the Regatta Secretary by email ASAP at ttarcregatta@gmail.com
- 19. In the event of the total cancellation of the Regatta, the Organising Committee will endeavour to refund entry fees paid once unavoidable costs have been covered. In the event of a partial cancellation of the Regatta or for events withdrawn, no refunds will be made.
- 20. The British Rowing membership insurance is only valid for UK residents who are resident in the country for more than six months in a year.
- 21. Talkin Tarn Country Park is open to the public and the Organising Committee are unable to prevent photography. Competitors should be aware of this prior to placing entries.
